

BRCC hosting Provincial Mixed Curling Championship

The Barrington Regional Curling Club will be hosting the 2012 Provincial Mixed Championship on March 9 to 13.

Twelve of the top mixed teams in Nova Scotia will be competing at the five day championship spiel.

"Barrington will be a great host community bringing to life the famous South Shore hospitality," said Aaron Sweeney, director of competitions for the Nova Scotia Curling Association (NSCA). "Because of that, the 2012 Mixed will be an event that will be remembered and talked

about for years to come."

The winning team will earn the right to represent Nova Scotia at the 2013 Canadian Mixed Curling Championships in Montreal on Nov. 15 to 24.

"Nova Scotia has a proud history for fielding strong mixed teams for the National Championships," said NSCA executive director, Jeremiah Anderson, adding this year, the "process starts in Barrington."

Teams in mixed competition are composed of two male and two female athletes, throwing in alternate order.
